## CCACA Announcement Women's Basketball - March 2018 Contact Period. (I) March 20, 2018

The NCAA academic and membership affairs staff has received multiple inquires related to the application of the March 2018 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball contact period. With the adoption of NCAA Division I Proposal No. 2016-118, which was effective Aug. 1, 2017, the staff noted the application of contact legislation in women's basketball during the month of March is as follows:

March 1 – 28 (11:59 pm in the prospective student-athlete's locale), 2018: Contact Period.

- Contact is permissible with high school juniors; however, contact may only occur at the prospective student-athlete's educational institution or residence; and
- Contact is permissible with high school seniors, post-graduate PSAs, two-year college PSAs, and four-year college PSAs at any location.

March 29, 2018: Contact Period.

- Contact is not permissible with high school juniors.
- Contact is permissible with high school seniors, post-graduate PSAs, two-year college PSAs, and four-year college PSAs at any location.

March 30 – 31, 2018: Dead Period.

• Contact is not permissible with prospective student-athletes.

The contact period for high school juniors concludes with the official start of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Convention, which is March 29, 2018. The convention schedule of events includes limited programming on March 28, 2018; however, that programming consists of closed sessions not available to all attendees.
