## Interpretation:

The Division II Legislation Committee determined that a scholastic team is one comprised of prospective student-athletes who are enrolled full time at the secondary institution with which the team is affiliated. A team that does not meet the above criteria may be considered a scholastic team only if the team is organized or administered within the parameters of a scholastic governing body (e.g., a state high school athletics association), and is eligible for events that are conducted by that governing body, including championship events.
