The academic and membership affairs staff confirmed it is not permissible for an institution to pay expenses for the institution's team to scout a future opponent as entertainment in conjunction with practice or competition. However, it is permissible for an institution's team to observe future opponents participating in the same event at the same site, even if there are expenses associated with the observation.
