High School Ambassador Program 2021-2022

To increase awareness of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association and the value of the association to high school girls' basketball coaches around the country, the WBCA has created a High School Ambassador Program. As an ambassador of the WBCA, you will assist the WBCA in recruiting members to the association by showing the value of what membership can offer to high school coaches and becoming an extension of the association's brand. There may be multiple ambassadors in a state. Each ambassador will be given a code to track their member recruits.

Ambassador Duties

- 1. Help define your state's target market.
- 2. Work with the WBCA to develop a strategy to target the high school coaches in your state.
- 3. Represent the WBCA at state coaches' association meetings, conventions and other basketball events if a part of the strategy and WBCA staff cannot attend.
- 4. Participate in WBCA digital campaigns (primarily email and social media) when appropriate.

Requirements

- 1. Complete the state questionnaire provided by the WBCA. This questionnaire will help guide the WBCA and the ambassador in creating the best strategy to target the state market.
- 2. Must be an active WBCA member. If your membership lapses, you will no longer be eligible to be a WBCA ambassador.
- 3. Must be an active high school girls' basketball coach in your state.
- 4. The WBCA strongly encourages the ambassador to participate in WBCA programs such as the Coach to Coach Mentoring Program and Coaches' Classrooms.

As a "thank you" for participating in the program, incentives for the 2021-22 year are as follows:

*Each ambassador will be considered active as long as they have attended a minimum of two meetings and/or have new members join the association utilizing their ambassador code.

This includes but is not limited to flyers and other print materials, digital graphics, social media posts, speaking points, etc. Materials will be printed by the WBCA and mailed to ambassadors prior to events (emailed if materials are digital).
