#### **Annual Meeting**

The Division III Women's Basketball Committee met April 20-21. They implemented a subcommittee researching officials video review during the regular season and conference tournaments. The chair-elect is Polly Thomason, head women's basketball coach, University of Texas at Dallas. Her chair term begins September 1.

# **Division III Championships Committee Actions**

- Championship cost savings measures for 2020-21 due to COVID-19:
  - No championship banquets (all sports, all divisions).
  - Year two of the two-year pilot program for avoiding first-round conference matchups regardless of geographic proximity has been suspended.
  - No in-person committee meetings.
- New sport regional alignment implementation in 2021-22, which changes women's basketball to a 10-region model. Teams to rank per region will be 20% of sponsorship of that region.
