## Texas's Kathleen Nash Awarded Robin Roberts/WBCA Broadcasting Scholarship

ATLANTA – Kathleen Nash of the University of Texas will receive the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) Robin Roberts/WBCA Broadcasting Scholarship Award.

The \$4,500 Robin Roberts/WBCA Broadcasting Scholarship Award is presented annually to one female collegiate basketball player who intends to pursue graduate work and a career in sports communications/journalism.

"I always look forward to presenting the Robin Roberts/WBCA Broadcasting Scholarship because it honors an individual who will pursue a career in sports communication/journalism," said WBCA CEO Beth Bass. "Congratulations to Kathleen. We look forward to watching you excel in your field, and hope you will put some 'pressure' on this award's namesake!"

Nash, a 6-foot-2 senior guard, is the first player in Texas history to record 1,000 points, 900 rebounds and 200 three-point field goals. The Plano, Texas, native leads the Longhorns in rebounding this season with 7.9 per game, including a team, season and career-high 20-rebound performance against Boston College.

A three-time Academic All-Big 12 First Team selection in 2009, 2010 and 2011, Nash will graduate in May with a degree in finance and a minor in accounting.

Nash will be formally recognized at the WBCA Awards Show at 6 p.m. Monday, April 4, in the Indiana Convention Center's Sagamore Ballroom. This event is part of the WBCA National Convention and is held in conjunction with the NCAA® Women's Final Four® in Indianapolis.
