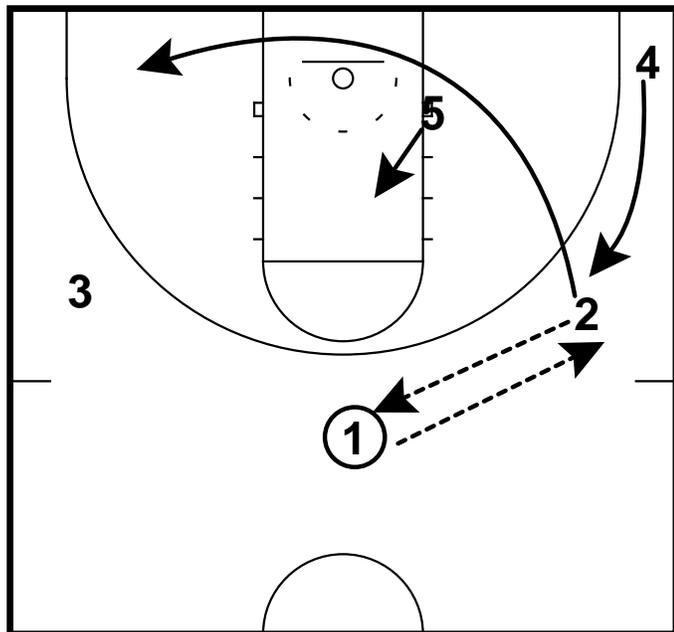

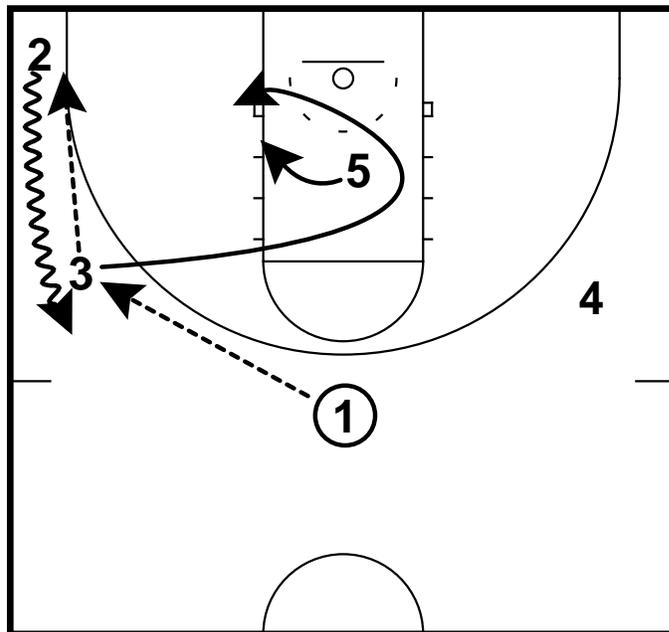
Motion vs 3/2 ZONE

Motion vs 3/2 ZONE
Zone Offense



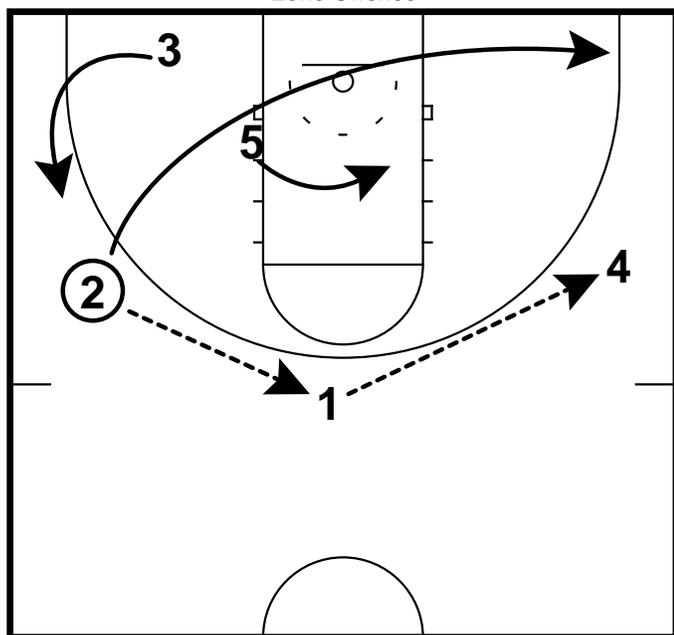
Start strongside. 1 to 2, 2 can puss up or down. 5 working to occupy low post defender. 2 back to 1, 2 cut opposite (never cut 5's face). 4 rises up.

Motion vs 3/2 ZONE
Zone Offense



5 wants to be a second behind the ball, still working to seal block to block. 1 has to penetrate looking to attack the nail and draw 2. 3 to 2 in corner, 2 dribble up. 3 cut around 5 to short corner.

Motion vs 3/2 ZONE
Zone Offense



Keep floor spread. Ball movement is key - quick reversals - inside/outs, look opposite. If 1 dribbles away from a wing spot the should come up with like attached w / a screen. 1 also looks for dumps to 5.
