

## Triangle Screening Drill Unknown



Triangle Screening works on teaching players how to move without the ball. Defensively, this drill can serve to work on the different ways you would like to defend a screen.

- Players can set any type of screen except an on-ball screen
- Players can only cut to the three spots in the initial set up (free throw line and blocks). KEY: maintain spacing!
- Ball will be entered to any player at the coach's discretion (ideally following a solid screen)
- Scoring: solid screen/score/reb = + 1
