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Welcome Party Guest Pass(es) — \$75

If you register to attend the convention, the Welcome Party is included in your registration fee. However, a \$75 pass must be purchased for each person who is not registered for convention but who will attend the Welcome Party with you as your guest.

This pass only gives your guest access to the Welcome Party. It does not provide access to other sessions, social events or the Courtside Expo. All persons, including guests, must be 21 years old or older to attend the party.

Registrants must pick up their Welcome Party pass — and their guest pass(es) if applicable — during registration hours.

Spouse/Partner Pass — \$200

The Spouse/Partner Pass allows a registered attendee's spouse or partner to attend WBCA educational sessions, the exhibit hall, and the 21+ Welcome Party. The pass is limited to one per registered attendee and is available only for spouses or partners who do not hold a position related to basketball in any capacity. Passes are subject to eligibility verification.

Registration Policy

- The WBCA must receive payment of all fees in full before confirming registration.
- Non-prospect age children accompanying their parent-members to convention are welcome at no charge provided they are supervised by a badge-wearing adult attendee. No registration required.
- All member coaches must comply with the applicable bylaws and policies of their respective governing bodies (such as NCAA, NAIA, NJCAA, etc.) that regulate contact with recruitable student-athletes while attending the WBCA Convention.

Cancellation of Registration

- All notices of cancellation must be submitted in writing from the original registrant (not from their employer or supervisor) via email or mail.
- The following administrative fees apply to registration costs ONLY:
 - Sept. 14, 2026, through Feb. 17, 2027 | \$50
 - Feb. 18 through March 18, 2027 | \$130
 - No shows | No refunds
- No refunds after March 18, 2027, with the exception of the following scenarios:
 - Death in immediate family. Registrant must submit email in writing along with proof of obituary. This will qualify for a full refund upon approval.
 - Sick and/or hospitalization. Registrant must submit an email describing the illness and must have a signed doctor's note. This will qualify for a partial refund and the cancel fee will still apply.
- Cancellations do not apply to NCAA Women's Final Four tickets.
- If a registrant cancels their registration then chooses to re-register at a later time, they can use the original cancellation fee toward their new registration payment. The registrant will be required to register at the current rate based on when they re-register.
- Appeals due to Acts of God must be submitted in writing no later than April 19, 2027.
- Refunds may not be processed until after April 19, 2027.
- Challenges due to travel and/or weather will not be considered for a convention registration refund.

Teams Participating in Women's Final Four

The WBCA appreciates those members who forgo their convention fees to the WBCA while they compete in the NCAA Women's Final Four in order to assist the association in fulfilling its mission.

Coaches and staff who register for convention and subsequently participate in the Women's Final Four (semifinal and championship rounds), however, may request their registration fees be credited toward registration for the next year's convention when their dates of tournament play coincide with the dates of the WBCA Convention. All requests for the credit must be made in writing by April 15th each year and submitted by email to Shayla Black at shayla.black@wbca.org.

The person(s) in question must also be active members in order to receive the credit. Membership dues and registration fees apply to the member and not the institution.

Transfer of Registration

- All requests for transfer of registration must be submitted in writing (email or mail).
- Transfers are for registration packages as purchased. The WBCA cannot break up an order (such as tickets).
- Transfers are only allowed between active WBCA members. If the recipient is not active, they must apply for either new membership or renew.
- A written notice from the original registrant (not from their employer or supervisor) is required.
- There is no fee to transfer a convention registration to another person.

Hotel Reservations

The NCAA will assign WBCA room blocks in hotels at locations convenient to the convention. We recognize that you have other options for accommodations; however, please use WBCA hotels when possible. The WBCA will notify convention registrants by email once room blocks have been assigned.

Women's Final Four Tickets

NCAA Women's Final Four tickets within the WBCA block will be available for purchase on WBCA.org (once we get confirmation from the NCAA). Tickets within the WBCA block are limited and will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis. You must be a convention registrant in order to purchase tickets in the WBCA block. All tickets will be registered to the email address associated with your WBCA account.
